



- These slides are intended to provide a helpful focus for a discussion of the content of the leaflets.
- The first prayer can be read by someone in the group and perhaps everyone could be invited to read the final prayer together.
- You might like to add a time of shared intercession before the final prayer.
- The story, the Scripture reading and the reflection that follows the Scripture reading, should be read slowly to accompany the slide.
- The questions for individual reflection – please feel free to choose which questions you'd like to discuss. Or you may prefer to give people time to reflect on their own at this point, perhaps with quiet music playing.
- During the concluding prayer you could light a candle, sing or play a hymn, repeat the passage of scripture that was used earlier and / or read a couple of lines from the story or reflection.
- Some practical steps a parish might take are provided with the supplementary materials which accompany the leaflets.
